3. Write the words in the order they are chosen, adding punctuation where you would like.

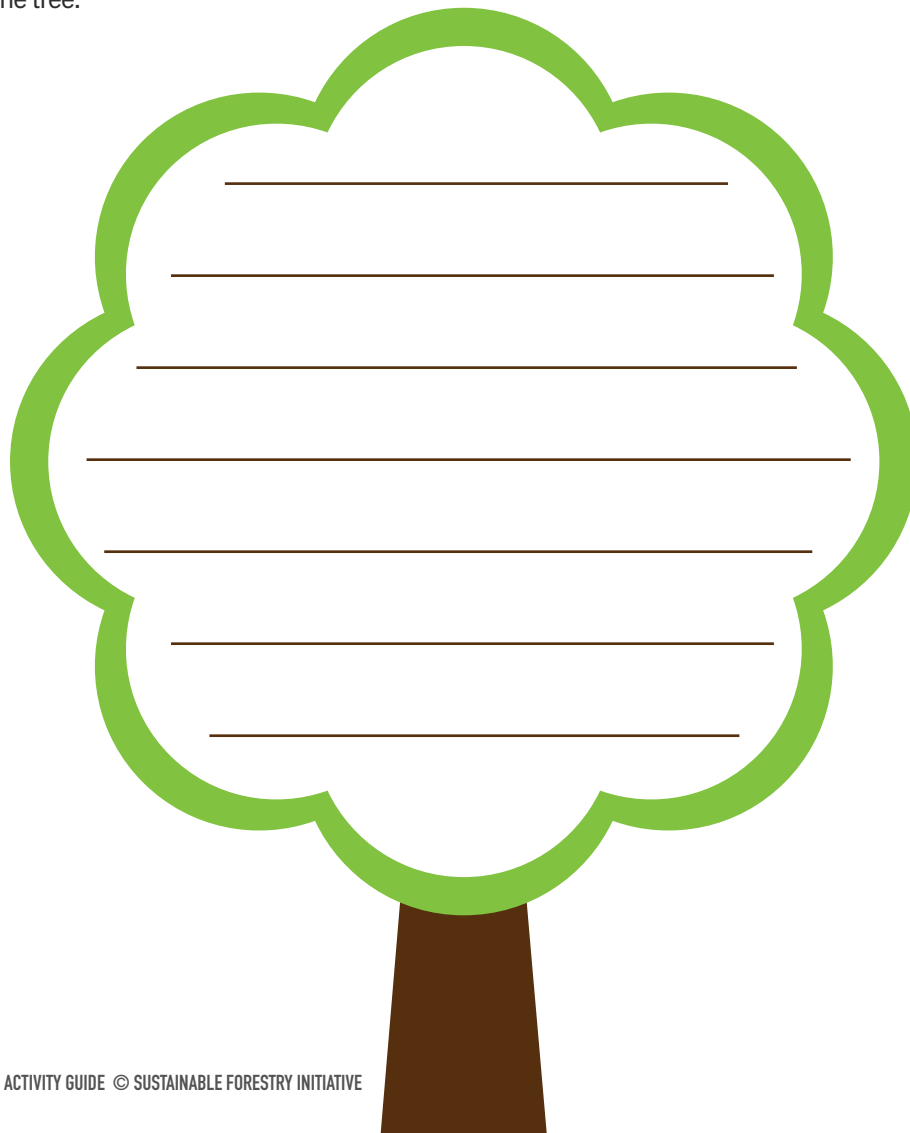
